## **GUEST POLICY**

Guests who are not immediate family members of a Naples Yacht Club member, nor a member of an approved reciprocal club, must be accompanied by a Member during their visit. Number of guest visits are limited and NYC Members may review the guest policy in full in the House Rules.

Reciprocal guests outside of the Florida Council of Yacht Clubs must be approved by the Executive Director of Membership must obtain a letter of good standing from their Club prior to securing reservations. Guests visiting from fellow Florida Council of Yacht Clubs should secure reservations prior to arrival.

Members shall be responsible for the conduct of guests on Club property. If the behavior or appearance of any guest is unsatisfactory, the hosting Member and/or the Guest of a Member may, at the request of Club Management, be asked to leave the premises.

## **DRESS CODE**

At all times, the following attire is not permitted.

• Blue denim, frayed or ripped clothing, clothing with offensive language or graphics shirtless attire, bathing suits, crop tops, tank tops, inappropriate length dresses, skirts, or shorts.

Daytime Attire (Before 5:00 p.m.)

- Shorts, collarless shirts, appropriate boating or athletic attire, and untucked shirts are permitted.
- Shirt and shoes required.

## Evening Attire (After 5:00 p.m.)

- Tucked in collared shirt and slacks required for gentlemen.
- Collarless shirts and shorts are not permitted.
- Jackets are not required unless noted in special event dress code.
- Shorts are only permitted after 5:00 p.m. May 1 through October 31.
